A veteran of the L.I. music scene, Cecilia has presented her songs as a solo performer and also as the leader of an electric/acoustic band. Her sweet voice, gracious stage demeanor and infectious smile delight her audience.

**MARTHA TRACHTENBERG** — Martha Trachtenberg is a founding member of the Buffalo Gals, the first all-female bluegrass band — and her solo for Folger's Coffee brought calls from friends and fans across the country who recognized her distinctive voice magic.
