The **Folk Music Society of Huntington's** **HARD LUCK CAFÉ** will present two performers:

Long Island Performers **The DAYDREAMERS**

The Daydreamers are veterans of Long Island's acoustic and rock scenes — the trio is comprised of much in-demand session men. Guitarist Bob Westcott, bassist Larry Hunter and Mike DiGeronimo, drummer, have cooked up a tasty blend of music best described as "Folkabilly".

Westcott's breathtaking skill as a fingerpicker takes on a whole new dimension on a cool red Gretsch, bassist Larry Hunter displays the driving rhythm and wonderful sense of humor that makes him such a favorite of Great Caesar's Ghost fans ... and Mike DiGeronimo keeps the backbeat on the gentle side with a snare and brushes.

Westcott been called the "real deal", and for good reason: Bob has been performing his elegant finger style guitar work for over 30 years. Larry Hunter spent his formative years as a musician in the San Francisco Bay area, where he performed and recorded with awesome groups; he now makes his home on Long Island. Drummer Mike DiGeronimo is a native Long Islander. A tireless jammer who prefers the straightforward simplicity of snare and brushes, he's an ardent supporter of the blues scene, performing with many notable local artists.

NY Performers **MILTON - The Full Milton Band**



Story-teller Milton is known for weaving rhymes in a hip-hop rhythm colored by country music sensibilities. A curious blend of Lucinda Williams and Jonathan Richman, Milton has one of those rare voices which is instantly identifiable, and backs up his catchy pop melodies with honest snapshots of ordinary people.

Milton is a singer/ songwriter from New York City. He is the author of the CD song collection *Milton: Scenes From the Interior* released in 2003 by Raleigh, NC indie label Moon Caravan. The CD's single *In The City* premiered on radio host Vin Scelsa's *Idiot's Delight* program on New York's WFUV in spring 2003 and became a local college radio hit .

Milton and his band can most often be seen at NYC's Living Room, where they've played countless one nighters and two month-long residencies. The full Milton live band will be here— made up of Sami Buccella- bass, Frank Campbell- piano and Adam Chasan- drums.
