Karyn Oliver, a singer-songwriter from Baltimore, has been turning heads on both sides of the Atlantic with her skillful songwriting and a passionate, soulful voice that could break your heart through a brick wall.

Oliver's musical inspiration comes primarily from the eclectic mix of music she was exposed to while growing up in the musically diverse culture of Washington, D.C. As a child, she learned to play rock 'n roll on her guitar, and being inspired by the likes of the Beatles and Carol King, to write some of her first songs — at the same time she was also being trained in both classical voice and musical theater. Her array of musical styles ranges from throbbing rock with a feminine tease to pure, silky love songs that will shatter your heart.

Marc is a different kind of singer/songwriter. In what amounts to song length works of fiction, Berardo's sharply drawn portraits cast a net on unusual and interesting characters and places. With a painter's eye for detail and music firmly rooted in the great American sound, he sings about towns full of circus retirees, expatriates in Florida rum bars, union iron workers, aimless New York City debutantes, near death car crashes, and of course, the changes that experience brings to everyone. All of these songs are brought to the stage with a relaxed and disarming stage presence, that makes for a fine night of music, laughter, emotion and insight. Marc delivers the "rare feat of being thought provoking and a pleasure to hear."
