LARA HERSCOVITCH *Charismatic*

Lara was raised in New York and lives in Connecticut. She narrowly escaped law school, training instead as a macro social worker. She has worked in the US, Latin America and Asia, on behalf of disadvantaged individuals – focusing on education, community development, human services, and the environment. Echoes of this work, including personal and global themes and questions of social justice and equity resonate throughout her music.

Her voice and performance style captivates you right away. She truly stands out in a crowd of rising folksingers. Her songs cover a broad range of topics: love, laughter, family, wisdom, poverty – the more you listen, the more you will like what she does – she delivers “pure musical poetry”.
