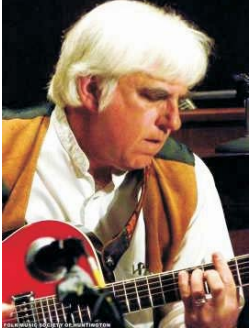

PRINCESS PEAPOD

The lively acoustic duo, Princess Peapod, features the rich linen-textured vocals of Michele Frimmer, with the inventive harmonies and multi-layered guitar style of Dave Cook. Princess Peapod combines a fresh lyrical approach with just the right amount of crunch and groove to make for third-millennium folk at its best. Princess Peapod's imaginative, often reflective, sometimes quirky songwriting has a universal appeal, reaching out to a diverse audience.
